On December 26th, a team comprised of veterans, attorneys, and community partners departed Philadelphia International Airport for Tanzania, Africa, where they embarked on a five and a half day climb up Mt. Kilimanjaro to benefit the Military Assistance Project (MAP). MAP, founded in 2011 by Albert Ciardi III of Ciardi, Ciardi & Astin, is a 501(c)(3) charity established to provide free legal services for active duty, reserve, or veteran military personnel in the form of pro bono bankruptcy services. Over \$25,000 in proceeds has been raised for the Military Assistance Project.

The MAP Charity Climb Team was comprised of attorneys, disabled veterans, MAP Board Members, and elected officials. Included in the roster of climbers are MAP Founder and Board Chairman, Albert Ciardi III and Pennsylvania State Representative Brian Sims (who missed his swearing-in-ceremony due to the trip).
